THE ADULT LITERACY PROGRAM

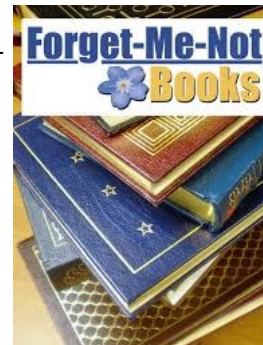
LCA provides all of the GED preparation classes along with English language courses to help adults reach their educational goals. Every year over 200 adults spend over 13,000 hours studying in our programs.

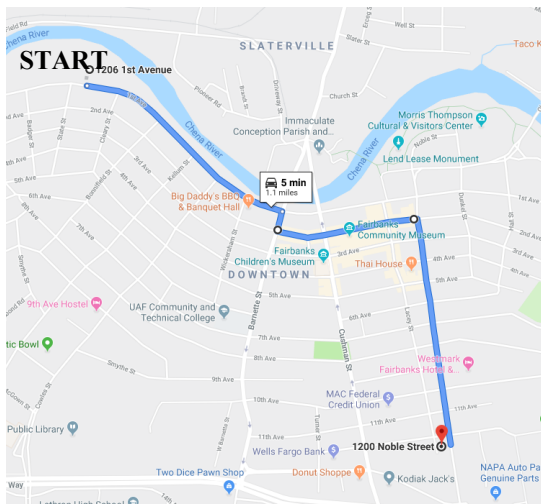
